PUBLIC CAMPING INFORMATION & RULES

Please read carefully, failure to follow rules may result in you being asked to leave the site.

- Please note there is no electric hook up on site.
- All pitches are on grass and sloping.
- Fresh water, elsan disposal point, rubbish bins and toilets are provided.
- Overnight security will be in place on Friday and Saturday all night.
- Maximum Gas Bottle size is 13/15kg, with only 1 per unit.
- No glass bottles or drinking vessels are allowed within the showground. Bag searches will be carried out by official security when entering the show ground.
- BBQ's All BBQ's (gas or disposable) must be on a raised platform with at least 300mm clearance from the ground due to fire risk. Mobile security staff will monitor the use of BBQ's, if in doubt please ask! Please consider the wind direction, smoke from your BBQ may affect fellow campers! Where there are very hot conditions, BBQ's may be banned if dead or dry grass poses a significant hazard of rapid fire spread across the site.
- No generators between the times of 9.00pm and 9.00am. Consider other campers.
- Please keep noise on the campsite to a minimum and respect other campers. Noise deemed excessive by the show organisers will not be tolerated.
- Dogs are welcome but must always be kept on leads, please clear up dog mess.
- Wristbands will be provided for weekend camping and must be worn at all times. You will not be able to enter the show site without these.
- Any problems / complaints / disputes must be reported to the show office adjacent to the main arena. All complaints will be dealt with by the Directors and the Health and Safety Officer, their decision is final.
- Chickerell Steam & Vintage Show accepts no liability for any loss, damage or injury caused whilst on site.

Please set up your unit as per instructions by the public camping stewards. Mandatory fire spacing regulations are applied for everyone's health and wellbeing. The decision of the steward is final.

Arrivals to the public camping area can access the site between 8.00am to 8.30pm Friday or Saturday. NO vehicle movements after 10pm. All campers must be clear of the site by 10.00am Monday 8th July 2024.

If you wish to camp together as a group you will need to arrive together and the stewards will do their best to keep you together.

Each pitch will be 8m x 7m

Only one vehicle will be admitted per pitch. Any other vehicles must park in the public car park.

You will be supplied with a camping pass for your vehicle which must be displayed in the windscreen on arrival.
